Gate and setup schedule (subject to change):

Thursday, 8am-9pm Setup in all areas. One hour allowed to unload vehicles. Period correct after setup. Friday, 6-9am & 4-9pm Setup in all areas. One hour allowed to unload vehicles. Period correct after setup. Saturday, 6-9am Setup all areas. **6-9am will be last chance to drive into primitive camp** Sunday, 6-9am Last chance for vehicles to enter the modern / short-term area.

Monday 1PM Memorial Day Service

Monday, after 3pm Tear down begins.

NOTE: Primitive areas must remain period correct until 3pm. (Please tear down as much as possible before bringing the vehicle into camp)

If you must tear down before 3pm Monday, you must set up in the short-term camp area. Primitive participants are allowed 1 hour to unload and remove their vehicles from camp. Primitive camps are to be period correct after setup. Outside of setup hours, participants may cart or pack into or out of the primitive areas, or set up in short term or modern areas. Camp prize drawing is for registered participants only

Directions (watch for signs near site)

<u>From Twin Cities:</u> 494 to Hwy. 52/55 (Inver Grove Heights). South on Hwy 52/55 to Hwy 56 (south) exit near Hampton. South on Hwy 56 to Hwy 19. Left (east) on Hwy 19 approx 0.5mi to the Whitson Farm on the left.

From Rochester: North on 52 to Hwy 19 exit in Cannon Falls. Left (west) on Hwy 19 approx 5mi to

Whitson Farm on the right. From Cannon Falls: Hwy 19 west approx 5mi to Whitson Farm on the right.

<u>From Northfield:</u> Hwy 19 east to Hwy 19/56 (Stanton). Left (north) on Hwy 19/56 to the Hwy 19 split. Right (east) on Hwy 19 1/4 mile to Whitson Farm on the left.
