Gate and setup schedule (subject to change):

Thursday: 8am-9pm Setup in all areas.

Friday: 6-9am & 4-9pm Setup in all areas.

Saturday: 6-9am Setup all areas. *6-9am is the last chance to drive into primitive camp*

Sunday: 6-9am modern / short-term area. *6-9am is the last chance to drive into modern / short-term camp area*

Monday 1PM Memorial Day Service

Monday: 3pm Tear down begins.

NOTE: Primitive areas must remain period correct until 3pm. Please tear down as much as possible before driving into camp.

- If you must tear down before 3pm Monday, you must set up in the short-term camp area.
- Primitive participants should attempt to unload and remove their vehicle from camp within 1 hour and must be period correct after setup.
- Outside of setup hours, participants may cart or pack into or out of the primitive areas, or set up in the short term or modern areas.

From Twin Cities: 494 to Hwy. 52/55 (Inver Grove Heights). South on Hwy 52/55 to Hwy 56 (south) exit near Hampton. South on Hwy 56 to Hwy 19. Left (east) on Hwy 19 approximately 0.5 miles to the Whitson Farm on the left.

From Rochester: North on 52 to Hwy 19 exit in Cannon Falls. Left (west) on Hwy 19 approximately 5 miles to the Whitson Farm on the right.

From Cannon Falls: Hwy 19 west approximately 5 miles to the Whitson Farm on the right.

From Northfield: Hwy 19 east to Hwy 19/56 (Stanton). Left (north) on Hwy 19/56 to the Hwy 19 split. Right (east) on Hwy 19 1/4 mile to the Whitson Farm on the left.
