Pets are allowed, but must be leashed at all times and cleaned up after.

Gate and setup schedule (subject to change):

Thursday, 8am-9pm	Setup in all camps. One hour allowed to unload vehicles. Period correct after setup.
Friday, 6-9am and 4-9pm	Setup in all camps. One hour allowed to unload vehicles. Period correct after setup.
Friday, 10am-4pm	Open to public. Primitive camps must be period correct.
Saturday, 6-9am and 4-9pm	Setup all camps. 6-9am will be last chance to drive into primitive camp to setup.
Saturday and Sunday, 10am-4pm	Open to the public.
Sunday, 6-9am	Last chance to enter modern/short-term camps.
Monday, 10am-3pm	Open to the public. Memorial Day Service at 1pm.
Monday, after 3pm	Tear down begins. Main primitive camps must remain period correct until 3pm. Please tear down as much as possible before bringing vehicle into camp.

If you must tear down before 3pm Monday, you must setup in the short-term camp area. Primitive campers are allowed 1 hour to unload and remove their vehicles from camp. Primitive camps are to be period correct after setup. Outside of setup hours, campers may cart or pack into or out of the primitive camps, or set up in short term or modern camp areas.

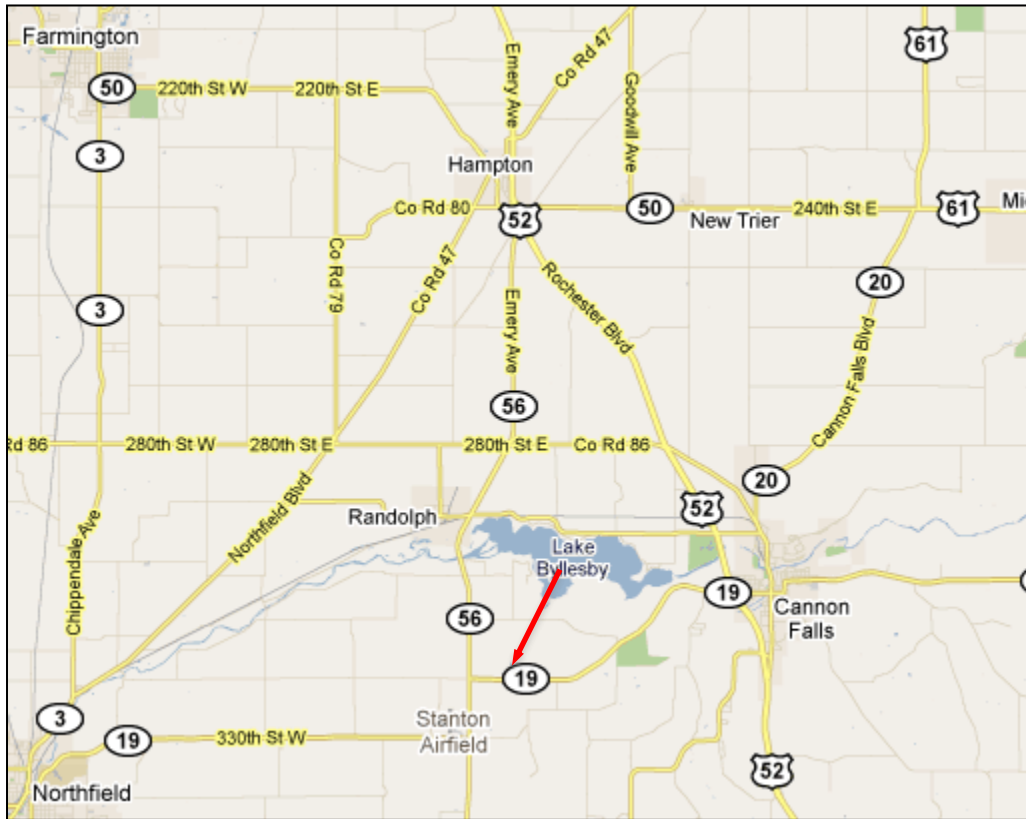

Directions (watch for signs near site):

From Twin Cities: 494 to Hwy. 52/55 (Inver Grove Heights). South on Hwy 52/55 to Hwy 56 (south) exit near Hampton. South on Hwy 56 to Hwy 19. Left (east) on Hwy 19 approx 0.5mi to the Whitson Farm on the left.

From Rochester: North on 52 to Hwy 19 exit in Cannon Falls. Left (west) on Hwy 19 approx 5mi to Whitson Farm on the right.

From Cannon Falls: Hwy 19 west approx 5mi to Whitson Farm on the right.

From Northfield: Hwy 19 east to Hwy 19/56 (Stanton). Left (north) on Hwy 19/56 to the Hwy 19 split. Right (east) on Hwy 19 1/4 mile to Whitson Farm on the left.
